The regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Henderson, Nebraska was held at 7:00 p.m. on November 13, 2018 at City Hall in Henderson, Nebraska. Notice of this meeting was posted at the City Hall and Post Office and published in the November 8, 2018 *Henderson News*.

Mayor Mike Yoder called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Yoder declared the meeting to be legal and properly advertised with all members having been informed of the nature of the meeting and having received related information. Mayor Yoder also referred to the open meetings law poster at the back of the council chambers.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Mike Yoder. Council members: Mike Wall, Corbin Tessman, Jeb Mierau and Lee Thiessen. Also present were Milan Mierau, Blake Grimes, Kelsey Bergen, Royce Schweitzer and Rachelle Schweitzer.

Minutes from the October 9, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Jeb Mierau made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Lee Thiessen seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Jeb Mierau, Lee Thiessen, Mike Wall and Corbin Tessman. Motion carried.

Mike Wall made a motion to pay the claims as presented along with the Perennial Public Power District invoices when they are received. Jeb Mierau seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Mike Wall, Jeb Mierau, Lee Thiessen and Corbin Tessman. Motion carried.

There were no building permits issued for last month.

Mike Wall made a motion to adopt Ordinance #416, An Ordinance To Repeal Section 6-104 of the Henderson City Code, Dogs; Owner Defined; To Provide For The Effective Date Of This Ordinance and to suspend the three readings on three different days. Jeb Mierau seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Mike Wall, Jeb Mierau, Corbin Tessman and Lee Thiessen. Motion carried.

Jeb Mierau made a motion to adopt Ordinance #417 after a correction of a typo, An Ordinance To Amend Section 6-106 of the Henderson City Code, Dogs; Running At Large; To Repeal All Ordinances In Conflict Herewith; To Provide For The Effective Date Of This Ordinance and to suspend the three readings on three different days. Lee Thiessen seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Jeb Mierau, Lee Thiessen, Mike Wall and Corbin Tessman. Motion carried.

Mike Wall made a motion to adopt Ordinance #418, An Ordinance To Repeal Section 6-111 of the Henderson City Code, Dogs; Liability of Owner; To Provide For The Effective Date Of This Ordinance and to suspend the three readings on three different days. Jeb Mierau seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Mike Wall, Jeb Mierau, Corbin Tessman and Lee Thiessen. Motion carried.

Mike Wall made a motion to adopt Ordinance #419, An Ordinance To Repeal Section 6-117 of the Henderson City Code, Dangerous Dogs; Definitions; To Provide For The Effective Date Of This Ordinance and to suspend the three readings on three different days. Jeb Mierau seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Mike Wall, Jeb Mierau, Lee Thiessen and Corbin Tessman. Motion carried.

Mike Wall made a motion to adopt Ordinance #420, An Ordinance To Amend Section 6-118 of the Henderson City Code, To Make It Unlawful To Harbor A Dangerous Dog; To Provide For A Penalty For The Violation Of This Ordinance; To Repeal All Ordinances In Conflict With; To Provide For The Effective Date Of This Ordinance and to suspend the three readings on three different days. Jeb Mierau seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Mike Wall, Lee Thiessen, Corbin Tessman and Jeb Mierau. Motion carried.

Mike Wall made a motion to adopt Ordinance #421, An Ordinance To Repeal Section 6-119 of the Henderson City Code, Dangerous Dogs; Confined; To Provide For The Effective Date Of This Ordinance and to suspend the three readings on three different days. Jeb Mierau seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Mike Wall, Jeb Mierau, Lee Thiessen and Corbin Tessman. Motion carried.

An interlocal agreement between the Henderson Police Department and the York County Sheriff Department was reviewed. After discussion of wording, Jeb Mierau made a motion to approve the interlocal agreement between the Henderson Police Department and the York County Sheriff Department as written. Mike Wall seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Jeb Mierau, Mike Wall, Corbin Tessman and Lee Thiessen. Motion carried.

The city council members signed the Mayor's letter of support to Governor Pete Ricketts to reduce the speed limit on Spur 93A over Interstate 80 to 45mph.

Reports were given. No formal action taken.

Jeb Mierau made a motion to adjourn. Mike Wall seconded. Roll vote: Ayes - Jeb Mierau, Mike Wall, Lee Thiessen and Corbin Tessman. Motion carried.
